## Code of Ethics for Research and Publications

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### 1. Preamble

The notion of academic freedom as the core principle, the University is committed to provide a vibrant intellectual space for academic excellence through leading age research activities. In undertaking this commitment, University expects its members (Faculty, Students, Researchers and Scholars) to adhere to Mertonian universal norms of conducting research scientifically. As integrity, accountability and responsibility in conducting academic research are the cornerstones of any academic institutions, the university encourage a culture of scientific ethics in research practices, ensuring that its principles are known and practiced at all levels of the University.

### 2. Objectives

This document is intended to provide a set of recommendations for responsible conduct of research and the governance of all research carried out across the University by upholding the highest level of integrity, rigour and excellence in all aspects of all research following appropriate ethical, legal and professional norms and frameworks.

### 3. Foundation of Good Research, its Principles and Practices

#### 3.1 Principles of Good Research

The researchers are advised to subscribe to normative principles<sup>1</sup> of conducting scientific research as a part of maintaining highest standards of integrity in conducting research. These norms are –

**Communism:** All researchers should have common ownership of research discoveries and methods and the consequent imperative to share them freely to promote collective collaboration.

**Universalism:** Everyone can do research, regardless of social status, race, nationality, gender, or any other differences. Validity of research results should be independent of the socio-political stature or personal attributes of researchers.

**Disinterestedness:** Researchers should work only for the benefit of research. Research findings should remain uncorrupted by self-interested motivations or biasness of researchers.

**Organized scepticism:** All research claims should be exposed to critical scrutiny before being accepted.

#### 3.2 Ethical Dimensions of Good Research

**Honesty-** An indispensable part of all research activities needed in every step of all research works starting from initial research design to final presentation of research results. It is expected that researchers will present information truthfully and accurately in proposing, conducting and reporting research along with ethical and legal bindings if any associated with the research undertaken.

**Trust-** A climate of mutual trust is essential to encourage free exchange of knowledge and ideas. This can potentially enhance research collaborations and the quality of research works. It is always desirable that academic fraternity should foster an environment of mutual trust.

**Rigour** –A way to establish trustworthiness in the findings of a research study by paying strong attention in detailing and adopting robust methodology, in drawing interpretations and conclusions from the research; and in communicating the results as per prevailing disciplinary norms and international standards or in adhering to an agreed protocol where appropriate.

**Transparency and open communication-** A way to demonstrate trust and confidence on research outcome by declaring potential competing interests, reporting research methodology, data and findings openly, responsibly and accurately.

**Fairness:** Establishing fairness in institutional standards, practices and procedures as well as fairness in interactions between members of the community can foster good research environment. Citing appropriately works of others as per institutional norms, giving credit, including authorship where appropriate, to those who have contributed to the research can augment fairness in research.

**Care and Respect:** Respect for all research participants, the wider community and care for animals and the environment are the pivotal requirements for responsible conduct of research.

**Legality:** Compliance to valid legal norms related to the conduct and publication of research is always desirable. Research should observe laws particularly in relations to copyright and intellectual property rights, Human Rights Act, National laws regarding the use of laboratory animals, terms and conditions regulating access to research resources.

**Accountability:** Ensure that any research undertaken complies with agreements, terms and conditions relating to the project if any. This includes ensuring there are fully auditable records of, for example, timesheets, participants' consent, where required, all relevant approvals, and have access to and understanding of any associated legal agreements, grant terms and conditions, etc. Researchers also advised to ensure good stewardship of public resources used to conduct research and to consider the consequences and outcomes of research prior to its communication.

### **3.3 Ethical Consideration of Research Projects**

Faculty members and scholars while undertake any research project, should consider ethical implications and impact of the research on –

- People involved in or affected by the research

- Welfare of animals
- Socio-cultural , Socio-political, Socio-economical dimensions and sensitivities
- Protected species and sites
- The environment

### 3.4 Publication Ethics-

Researchers are encouraged to publish their research and research findings in an appropriate form (peer reviewed journal article/ Book chapter/ Book, etc) of publications for wider dissemination. While doing so, researchers are advised to follow the latest guidelines laid down by COPE<sup>2</sup> (Committee on Publication Ethics) and ICMJE<sup>3</sup> (International Committee of Medical Journal Editors) for maintaining high integrity in publications.

### 4. Research Misconduct

Misconduct in academic research includes the intentional fabrication, falsification or plagiarism in proposing, performing, or reviewing research, or in reporting research results along with deliberate deviations from the accepted practice of carrying out research. It does not include honest errors, differences of opinion, or authorship disputes<sup>4</sup>.

- *Fabrication*: Invention / making up of research data or cases, and results.
- *Falsification*: Wilful distortion of data, image, etc. It also includes changing or omitting data or results when it does not accurately reflect the research but fit with desired results.
- *Plagiarism*: copying of ideas, data, or words without proper attribution
- *Abuse of Intellectual Property Rights(IPR)*: Failure to observe legal norms of IPR including copyright and the moral rights of authors.
- *Abuse of Research Resources*: Failure to observe the terms and conditions of institutionally licensed research resources.
- *Personation*: The situation arises when someone other than the researcher who has submitted any academic work has prepared (parts of) the work.
- *Sabotage*: Wilfully disrupting the experiments of others or acting to prevent others from completing their work.
- *Professorial misconduct*: Professorial acts that are arbitrary, biased or exploitative.

### 5. Researcher's Role

- Support a culture of responsible research conduct at the institution and in their field of practice.
- Ensure that the ethics principles of research merit and integrity, justice, beneficence and respect are applied to human research.
- Maintain the highest standards of rigour and integrity in all research works at all times.

- Comply with legal and professional frameworks, obligations and standards as required by statutory and regulatory authorities, employers, funders and other relevant stakeholders.
- Disclose and manage actual, potential or perceived conflicts of interest.
- Handle potential instances of research misconduct in an appropriate manner, acting in good faith and taking reasonable steps to ensure any recommendations made by formal research misconduct investigation panels are implemented.
- Monitor and report any adverse events occurring in the course of your research according to the process in your department to Ethics Committee.
- Acknowledge those who have contributed to the research.
- Cite and acknowledge other relevant work appropriately and accurately.
- Retain clear, accurate, secure and complete records of all research including research data and primary materials. Where possible and appropriate, allow access and reference to these by interested parties.
- Disseminate research findings responsibly, accurately and broadly. Where necessary, take action to correct the record in a timely manner.

## 6. University's Role in maintain Ethical Practices

6.1 *Training and Awareness*: The institutions will periodically organise seminars, workshops etc. to facilitate training and supervision in research ethics and have routines for handling ethical questions and cases. Emphasis will also be given on continued education and training to keep researchers apprised of contemporary issues related to research integrity and publication ethics.

6.2 *Leadership and supervision*: The Chief/Principal Investigators are responsible for ensuring proper ethical review of researches undertaken. They also ensure that research scholars working under his supervision are fully aware of, and comply with, the University's expectations for the ethical conduct of research, the ethical requirements of research funders, and the expectations of the concerned research discipline.

6.3 *Setting of Ethics Committee*: The University has set up central Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) and directed every department to set up Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP). These panels will be functioning to promote the best practices by all its research scholars. However, in the event of any unwanted misconduct observed within the University or its constituent unit, the respective DAIP will investigate the case and in consultation with IAIP shall take appropriate measures to prevent such incidences.

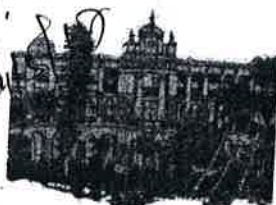
